“Adult Catechesis” - Lent

- 1) Lent is a time of preparation for the celebration of Easter. The liturgy prepares the catechumens for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery by the various stages of Christian initiation: it also prepares the faithful, who recall their Baptism and do Penance in preparation of Easter.
- 2) The weekdays of Lent from Ash Wednesday to the Saturday before Palm Sunday take precedence over the memorials of Saints, which therefore may be celebrated only in the form laid down by the Liturgical books.
- 3) The Alleluia is always omitted in the Celebration of the Eucharist/Mass.
- 4) The Gloria in excelsis (Glory to God in the highest) is not said or sung during Lent.
- 5) It is not permitted to adorn the Altar with flowers, and the organ and other instruments may only be played for the purpose of sustaining singing. An exception is made for Laetare Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), and for Solemnities and feasts (CB,252)
- 6) For the celebration of Marriages. The Parish Priest should alert spouses to the need to take account of the particular penitential character of this season (OM,32)
