Adult Catechesis:- The Sacrament of Baptism - Part 2

1280 - Baptism marks the Baptized person with permanent/irremovable character/sign (The Sign of the Cross) which consecrated her/him for Christian worship and because of the permanent /irremovable sign/ character of Baptism it cannot be repeated ie once Baptized always Baptized, no matter what.

1281- The following are saved even if they are not Baptized:

- a) Those who die for the Christian Faith (Martyrs)
- b) Those who die as Catechumens (those undergoing formation to receive Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist)
- c) Those who through no fault of their own do not know Jesus Christ and the Gospel but act under the inspiration of Grace/ Holy Spirit and seek God sincerely and strive to do Gods will.

1282 - Since the time of the Apostles, Baptism has been administered even to children, because it is a Grace and a Gift from God for All people, that does not pre-suppose any Human condition and merit. Children are Baptized with the same Baptism as adults which is that of Jesus Christ and His Church and in the Faith of the Church.

1283 - With respect to adults and children who have died without Baptism, the Church invites us to trust in God's Mercy and desire that all maybe saved, and to pray for their Salvation.

1284 - In case of emergency and a Cleric is not available, any person can Baptize provided that they have the intention of doing that which the Church does and provided that they/ immerse or pour water on the candidates head and saying: "So and so; I baptise you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit"
