Infection protocol: Adults – this can be maintained for 2 weeks

1. I/v/e/r/m/e/c/t/i/n: For the South African variant use 0.4mg/kg for 5 days or until better (check this with your doctor)
2. Aspirin (if not contraindicated): 325mg per day
3. Vitamin C: 2000mg three times daily
4. Zinc: 100mg per day total
5. Vitamin D: 5000-6000IU per day
6. Magnesium: 500mg twice daily
7. Omega-3: 4000mg daily
8. Probiotic (broad spectrum): Daily

Optional:

1. Quercetin especially co-morbid (500mg twice daily)
2. Multinutrient: Vitamin A, B1, selenium
3. Melatonin: Dr prescribed 10mg at night
